High School Parking Information

Student parking at TCCS is a privilege. Students who drive a vehicle to school are required to be licensed by the DMV, insured, and abide by all California Vehicle Code laws, including new driver regulations. Due to limited space, we may not be able to accommodate all students with on-campus parking, in which case, students may have to park off campus. Permit tags will be distributed the following week and must be displayed in the vehicle while parked on campus. Vehicles without permits will not be allowed to park on campus.

- Student drivers are permitted to park in the gravel lot only, with the exception of assigned senior spaces. All remaining open spaces in the paved parking lot are for faculty and staff
- Student drivers must obtain permission from TCCS staff prior to returning to their vehicle during the school day
- Violation of parking regulations (including the 5 mph speed limit) can result in suspension or loss of parking permit
- SENIORS with off-campus lunch privileges must sign out and in when leaving and returning to campus
