Application Fee \$150 - One-time fee for new students (includes testing). This fee is non-refundable.

Tuition & I-20 Information

Tuition is due in full at the time of enrollment. The I-20 will not be issued until the student is accepted, enrolled, and the non-refundable tuition is paid in full. At that time, the student must take the I-20 and the acceptance letter to the immigration office to receive permission to attend school in the United States. If an international student is unable to secure a Visa after the tuition has been paid, Tri-City Christian School will refund 92% of the tuition amount. An 8% fee will be retained to cover costs incurred by the school.

Supplies, Chromebooks, and Consumables: All students in grades 7-12 are required to have a personal Chromebook for school use (or rent one for \$3 per day). Teachers will provide a list of supplies that students need to purchase for their classes at the beginning of each semester. Students in grades 7-12 are required to purchase various consumable books and workbooks. The fees for these consumables vary by grade level and course selections. Provided textbooks must be returned at the end of the school year. If textbooks are damaged or lost, parents will be charged for repair or replacement when damages are assessed.

Uniforms All Kindergarten through 12th grade students are required to purchase and wear TCCS uniforms. All **7th - 12th grade** students must purchase and wear TCCS PE uniforms for all physical education classes.
